## **CARE & CLEANING**

All parts can be cleaned with hard-surface disinfectant.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Test dominent hand first
- Position board horizontally with round container next to hand being tested
- Read the following directions to person being tested

This will be a practice test. Pick up the pegs one at a time using the hand to be tested only. Place them in the holes until all nine holes are filled. Then remove all of them one at a time. The pegs can be placed in the holes in any order. This is a practice test. Are you ready? Begin!

- 4. If person being tested does not understand instructions, demonstrate first
- 5. After person completes practice test, read the following:

This will be the actual test. Pick up the pegs one at a time using the hand to be tested only. Place them in the holes until all nine holes are filled. Then remove all of them one at a time. The pegs can be placed in the holes in any order. Are you ready? Begin!

- Start stopwatch as soon as person touches first peg, and stop stopwatch as soon as last peg hits container
- 7. Reposition unit so round container is next to non-dominant hand. Repeat test in same way for non-dominant hand.
